2.1	Intensive Outpatient Services	Structured program delivering 9-19 hours per week, before/after work/school to meet complex needs of individuals with addition and co-occurring conditions.	\$250 1 unit = 1 day (min 3 hrs/day)
2.5	Partial Hospitalization Services	20 or more hours of clinically intensive programming per week with a planned format of individualized and family therapies.	\$500 1 unit = 1 day (min 5 hrs/day)
3.1	Clinically managed low intensity residential services	Alcohol and/or drug abuse halfway house services. Offering supportive living environment with 24-hour staffing with integration of clinical services.	\$175 1 unit = 1 day
3.3	Clinically managed population-specific high intensity residential services	Adult Residential based inpatient: Offering alcohol and / or drug services and sub-acute detoxification in a therapeutic rehabilitative facility to address cognitive impairment including developmental delay.	Max: \$393.50 1 unit = 1 day
3.7	Medically monitored intensive inpatient services (Adult)  Medically monitored high intensity inpatient services (Adolescent)	Offering alcohol and/or other drug treatment program. Planned and structured regimen of 24 hour professionally directed evaluation and observation. Settings include freestanding facilities, RTC, a specialty unit in a general, psychiatric hospital, acute inpatient or other licensed health care facility.	Based on type of facility per diem rate  1 unit = 1 day
4.0	Medically managed intensive inpatient services	Offering alcohol and/or drug services and acute detoxification in an acute inpatient setting. Inpatient Services consist of 24 hour nursing care and daily physician care for severe, unstable problems in dimensions 1, 2 or 3. Counseling services also available.	Based on type of facility per diem or DRG (based on provider's contract with health plan/Magellan)  1 unit = 1 day
Peer Supports	Peer support services – Individual & Group	Offering self-help peer Services. Peer provided services to initiate clinical service utilization and self-determination strategies. Patient education; non-physician provider, group, per session	\$2.50 Group \$6.50 Individual 1 Unit=15 minutes
