1 (The following proceedings were transcribed via
2 audio recording.)

3 MR. GOODYEAR: Good. How are you doing?

4 MR. LARSEN: Yeah, I left my card out there
5 earlier. I'm sorry.

6 How are you doing? Detective Larsen.

7 MR. GOODYEAR: Wow. What's going on?

8 MR. SADOWSKY: I -- I just had a few questions
9 if you have time. Should we --

10 MR. GOODYEAR: No. I'm --

11 MR. SADOWSKY: -- go inside the store or --

12 MR. GOODYEAR: I'm good right here.

13 MR. SADOWSKY: Inside?

14 MR. LARSEN: That's fine. Yeah.

15 MR. GOODYEAR: I was sitting there.

16 MR. LARSEN: You can still eat.

17 MR. GOODYEAR: No, I can wait.

18 MR. LARSEN: Yeah. You can eat if you want. We
19 don't want to tear your lunch up.

20 MR. GOODYEAR: What's going on?

21 MR. SADOWSKY: Well, we came earlier and we
22 heard the TV. We didn't know if you were home. We didn't see
23 a [inaudible].

24 MR. GOODYEAR: The TV [inaudible].

25 MR. SADOWSKY: It's a good idea. We thought you

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1 were home, so it worked, but...

2 Um, so Trevor and I work on a -- a task force
3 down -- downtown, a cyber crime task force --

4 MR. GOODYEAR: Okay.

5 MR. SADOWSKY: -- and we saw some activity
6 coming from your residence that looked a little bit suspicious.

7 MR. GOODYEAR: What's going on?

8 MR. SADOWSKY: Do you -- do you know why we
9 might be here --

10 MR. GOODYEAR: No.

11 MR. SADOWSKY: -- today or --

12 MR. GOODYEAR: No.

13 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. Are you a member on any
14 forums online or --

15 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, I'm a member of a few
16 different forums.

17 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. Any hobbies or --

18 MR. GOODYEAR: Any hobbies? Yeah. I do -- I
19 have -- I do motorcycles and my truck online -- online as well.

20 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. And how about astronomy?

21 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, I do astronomy.

22 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. So do you kind of know why
23 we might be here?

24 MR. GOODYEAR: No. I have no idea.

25 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. So, um, I'll tell you --

2 Have you ever heard of a website called
3 Astronomics or cloudy- --

4 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, I've ordered --

5 MR. SADOWSKY: -- -nights.com?

6 MR. GOODYEAR: I've ordered from cl- --
7 Astronomics before. And Cloudy Nights is a website forum.
8 Yes. I know of them all as well.

9 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

10 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, I visit a bunch of
11 different forums. Now --

12 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

13 MR. GOODYEAR: -- I'm wondering --

14 MR. SADOWSKY: You're -- you're a member on the
15 forum, or you just kind of browse?

16 MR. GOODYEAR: On Cloudy Nights, I usually just
17 browse. I used to be a member there a long time ago, over a
18 couple years ago, but I got banned as far as I know, so I never
19 tried logging in again, so...

20 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. So you haven't visited
21 under any usernames or anything recently?

22 MR. GOODYEAR: As in -- I visit there, yes. I
23 was there, in fact, yesterday.

24 MR. SADOWSKY: So it's not just a forum?

25 MR. GOODYEAR: I'm no astronaut. I hope --

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1 like, certain things [inaudible] wondering.

2 MR. SADOWSKY: For a telescope?

3 MR. GOODYEAR: For a telescope, yes.

4 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

5 MR. GOODYEAR: They have -- they're one of the
6 best websites to go to for research.

7 MR. SADOWSKY: Cloudy Nights or
8 cloudy nights.com?

9 MR. GOODYEAR: I usually order from Astronomics
10 or other places outside of California, trying to avoid the taxes.
11 Hopefully, that's not what you're here for.

12 MR. SADOWSKY: Oh, okay. No. Is that the same
13 company, Astronomics and Cloudy Nights, or --

14 MR. GOODYEAR: I have no -- I don't know if they
15 are or not, but I do know Astronomics is a sponsor of theirs, I
16 guess, the best I could say.

17 MR. SADOWSKY: Oh, okay.

18 MR. GOODYEAR: I can see their advertising on
19 their website.

20 MR. SADOWSKY: Got it.

21 So what were you banned for?

22 MR. GOODYEAR: Years ago, I was just mouthing
23 off. I was just started. Started out in astronomy and I was
24 mouthing off to the administrators -- or the moderators and
25 stuff like that.

1 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. You were younger or
2 something?

3 MR. GOODYEAR: Well, it was, like, six years
4 ago, probably.

5 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

6 MR. GOODYEAR: At least. Yeah. I would just --
7 just --

8 MR. SADOWSKY: Riot?

9 MR. GOODYEAR: -- riot. Yeah, riot. Yeah, just
10 thinking I knew more than some of these other people.

11 MR. SADOWSKY: We were talking before we came.
12 We were, like, how can you get banned from an astronomy --

13 MR. GOODYEAR: I --

14 MR. SADOWSKY: What kind of arguing leads to
15 that?

16 MR. GOODYEAR: It happens where -- just because
17 people start having disagreements. I mean, other people might
18 detour and then the administrators think that you're taking it
19 too far -- or you -- or maybe you push it a little bit too far
20 like I did and I got banned, so...

21 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah.

22 MR. GOODYEAR: I deserved it. There was nothing
23 wrong with that.

24 MR. SADOWSKY: Sure. So they banned your user
25 IP or they banned your username?

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1 MR. GOODYEAR: As far as I know -- I know they
2 banned my username, and I believe they -- I believe they banned
3 my IP. I'm not sure because I can still get on the site now,
4 so I'm not sure.

5 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

6 MR. GOODYEAR: I thought they might -- might
7 have, but I'm not sure.

8 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. What -- what name do you
9 order under through Astronomics?

10 MR. GOODYEAR: Dave Goodyear.

11 MR. SADOWSKY: Oh, your own name?

12 Let me -- let me just throw out this username to
13 you: Have you ever had a user account for James Sober?

14 MR. GOODYEAR: No.

15 MR. SADOWSKY: What's your ISP here?

16 MR. GOODYEAR: Cox. No, Time Warner. I'm
17 sorry.

18 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. Do you have an office or
19 anything?

20 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah. It's -- my Internet is for
21 my -- my business.

22 MR. SADOWSKY: Through Cox?

23 MR. GOODYEAR: Through Cox, right. I have
24 multiple users that come in and out, so...

25 MR. SADOWSKY: If you have any questions, be

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1 sure --

2 MR. GOODYEAR: I hope nobody has -- did somebody
3 possibly hamper my system or hack it or something or...

4 MR. LARSEN: That's one of the things we're
5 probably going to get to here and see.

6 MR. GOODYEAR: I've heard of a James Sober
7 online.

8 MR. SADOWSKY: Who is that?

9 MR. GOODYEAR: I've seen him. I can see their
10 notes and comments. I don't -- I've heard that they're in the
11 area.

12 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. What do you do for a
13 living?

14 MR. GOODYEAR: Information technology,
15 networking. I run my own business, run the personnel.

16 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. Do you rent the house or
17 own it?

18 MR. GOODYEAR: I own it.

19 MR. SADOWSKY: Oh, nice. It's a nice house.

20 MR. GOODYEAR: Thank you.

21 I have a little home office. I have guys come
22 in, just grab their work and just be done, surf the Internet
23 real quick, do what they need to do and bail.

24 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. Okay. So what did you
25 buy?

1 MR. GOODYEAR: I think I had a problem with them
2 years ago where they thought I defrauded them. I bought
3 something on eBay through Astronomics and then took the card
4 through a different person, apparently. It was off a bunk
5 credit card. I ended up sending their stuff back, so...

6 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. So, in --

7 MR. GOODYEAR: But I didn't buy from them a lot.

8 MR. SADOWSKY: -- 2016, it says -- I'm reading
9 in a document that you bought a telescope from the classified
10 section of Astronomics.

11 MR. GOODYEAR: Yes, I did.

12 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. And then after -- like,
13 very soon after, the same telescope -- pictures of the same
14 telescope was posted under the James Sober username on Cloudy
15 Nights. Was that --

16 MR. GOODYEAR: Okay.

17 MR. SADOWSKY: -- you that posted those
18 pictures?

19 MR. GOODYEAR: No. I didn't post any pictures.
20 Did I? No.

21 MR. SADOWSKY: You never posted any pictures?

22 MR. GOODYEAR: I never -- I have posted on
23 Cloudy Nights before to sell stuff, yes, but I'm not sure what
24 telescope you're talking about. Now, I've sold my telescopes
25 to other people.

1 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. You buy a lot of
2 telescopes if you don't -- if you don't know which telescope
3 you bought.

4 MR. GOODYEAR: A lot.

5 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

6 MR. GOODYEAR: I have -- on Astromart, I have
7 over three hundred -- two hundred and something feedback on --
8 I buy and sell a lot of telescopes, and it's in the tens of
9 thousands of dollars of those things. Very cheap telescopes
10 and very expensive telescopes.

11 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

12 MR. LARSEN: What's your username on Astromart?

13 MR. GOODYEAR: Wolfman_4_ever.

14 MR. LARSEN: Wolfman --

15 MR. GOODYEAR: Underscore 4.

16 MR. LARSEN: The letter or --

17 MR. GOODYEAR: The number four.

18 MR. LARSEN: Yeah.

19 MR. GOODYEAR: Underscore --

20 MR. LARSEN: Yeah.

21 MR. GOODYEAR: -- ever, E-V-E-R.

22 MR. LARSEN: Okay. It's astromart.com?

23 MR. GOODYEAR: Correct. Now, on some of my
24 other guys, it's possible. I don't know. I know some of them
25 are into astronomy as well, so I don't know if something else

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1 is going on that I need to know about or...

2 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. So are you familiar with
3 this post here? Like, the post is actually moving this.

4 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, I've seen this because when
5 I was banned -- when I was banned a few years ago.

6 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. This is pretty recent.

7 MR. GOODYEAR: This was when I tried to log in
8 years ago to post on here. We're not allowed to see users --

9 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

10 MR. GOODYEAR: -- because I was banned.

11 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah. But -- but who posted it
12 is the question.

13 MR. GOODYEAR: I have no idea.

14 MR. SADOWSKY: Could it be one of your -- you
15 said one of your employees?

16 MR. GOODYEAR: It could either be that or maybe
17 I got hacked. I have no idea.

18 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. So you -- you don't have
19 an AT&T connection?

20 MR. GOODYEAR: No, no. I -- no. I have no AT&T
21 connection.

22 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

23 MR. LARSEN: Cell phone? AT&T cell phone?

24 MR. GOODYEAR: Yes, I do have an AT&T cell
25 phone. Yes.

1 MR. LARSEN: Okay. Do you connect to that with
2 a laptop?

3 MR. GOODYEAR: I have connected to that website,
4 yes, from -- with my cell phone.

5 MR. LARSEN: With -- okay.

6 MR. GOODYEAR: Signing in with mobile AT&T --

7 MR. LARSEN: You know, sometimes you can tether
8 your phone or whatever with the iPad or something.

9 MR. GOODYEAR: No, I don't do that. No. But I
10 do surf the Internet on my phone, and I do -- in fact,
11 yesterday, I was on it with my phone.

12 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. So after -- after you were
13 banned from Cloudy Nights, this was posted. Was that with your
14 IP?

15 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, that is my IP. I don't
16 know.

17 MR. LARSEN: That's your current IP right now?

18 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah. This was a year ago.
19 Yeah. That's my I- -- that's my account, and that's probably
20 something I did send to them because I was a smart-ass.

21 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah. You were pissed off.

22 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, I was pissed off. And you
23 can see the date. That's right. That's my e-mail address, you
24 know, and then the date was in 2014, so that's about right,
25 again.

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1 MR. SADOWSKY: So are you familiar with that --
2 you -- since you kind of are on the forum, do you kind of be --

3 MR. GOODYEAR: I can't log into the forum, so I
4 don't have -- so I just visit there for --

5 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah. When you were visiting,
6 did you see sort of what, like, shook down with James Sober
7 and --

8 MR. GOODYEAR: I don't visit there that often.

9 MR. SADOWSKY: You guys, what --

10 MR. GOODYEAR: I mean, I visit probably once a
11 week, not every single day. It's not something to see -- to
12 see what's going on in the -- how would I say? -- what the
13 politics are going on. It's just --

14 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah.

15 MR. GOODYEAR: -- usually for research.

16 MR. SADOWSKY: Like, if someone's having a
17 problem on the forum, you would have known --

18 MR. GOODYEAR: No.

19 MR. SADOWSKY: -- day to day --

20 MR. GOODYEAR: Not anymore. Because I totally
21 kind of washed my -- not -- I kind of washed my hands of that
22 website so where I went -- again, it's the number one site to
23 research, like, if I'm looking for somebody to do business
24 there, so that's where I'm usually at if I need to, like, check
25 something.

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1 MR. SADOWSKY: Sure. Do you -- you said your
2 employees are interested in astronomy?

3 MR. GOODYEAR: Here and there, yeah.

4 MR. SADOWSKY: Did they ban their -- the
5 username that's [inaudible] --

6 MR. GOODYEAR: Not that I'm aware of.

7 MR. SADOWSKY: They don't have any problems with
8 that forum or --

9 MR. GOODYEAR: I don't delve into their personal
10 life, so -- it's not my job.

11 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. So I guess -- so the
12 company right now -- I don't know if you know. If you visit
13 that site a lot, you might --

14 MR. GOODYEAR: Which site? Cloudy Nights?

15 MR. SADOWSKY: Both of them. Astronomics and --
16 and Cloudy Nights.

17 MR. GOODYEAR: I was on there yesterday.

18 MR. SADOWSKY: So --

19 MR. GOODYEAR: At least, Cloudy --

20 MR. SADOWSKY: -- it's the same --

21 MR. GOODYEAR: -- Cloudy Nights.

22 MR. SADOWSKY: It's the same company, and
23 they've been experiencing a denial of service attack, which I'm
24 sure --

25 MR. GOODYEAR: I do know what that is.

1 MR. SADOWSKY: -- you know --

2 MR. GOODYEAR: I've been exp- -- I've
3 experienced those myself, so...

4 MR. SADOWSKY: Sure. So they're experiencing a
5 denial of service attack; they've had issues with your username
6 in the past.

7 MR. GOODYEAR: Okay.

8 MR. SADOWSKY: And based on some analysis of
9 usernames, IP addresses, and everything else, they -- they have
10 a strong suspicion -- and obviously the FBI --

11 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, that's highly illegal.

12 MR. SADOWSKY: -- the office that they're
13 located in sent us a request --

14 MR. GOODYEAR: Okay.

15 MR. SADOWSKY: -- to ask you what your
16 involvement is in that.

17 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, I have no clue what's going
18 on with that. Again, I just -- they're a site here and there.
19 I usually order from Astronomics --

20 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah.

21 MR. GOODYEAR: -- again, to avoid taxes, and I
22 have no clue. I mean, I know nothing -- at least, I don't have
23 heavy traffic coming in and out of my site, so...

24 I mean, I run my own mail server and stuff like
25 that out of here, so...

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1 MR. SADOWSKY: Sure. Well, you don't need a --
2 as you know, you don't need a lot of traffic. Let's say you --

3 MR. GOODYEAR: No.

4 MR. SADOWSKY: -- you know --

5 MR. GOODYEAR: Not for --

6 MR. SADOWSKY: -- commissioned botnet or some
7 kind of --

8 MR. GOODYEAR: No. That's not my forte. I --
9 I -- I'm not that type to even -- don't even know about -- I
10 mean, I know what botnets are, but I thought a lot of that had
11 been dealt away with by the version six networks and stuff like
12 that, so...

13 MR. SADOWSKY: Sure.

14 MR. GOODYEAR: But I'm sure something is going
15 to go on.

16 MR. SADOWSKY: Sort of the, I guess, the status
17 of the case now is: Before the FBI really dives into
18 something -- I'm sure LAPD works this way, too -- like, go --
19 go get bits of evidence like this from the victim, a little bit
20 of analysis, and then go out and talk to, like, the first
21 target, you know, that they think could be involved, but --

22 MR. GOODYEAR: Yeah, I know exactly what you're
23 saying.

24 MR. SADOWSKY: Let me just explain.

25 MR. GOODYEAR: Oh, I'm sorry.

1 MR. SADOWSKY: What's going to happen is I'm
2 going to take this --

3 MR. GOODYEAR: Okay.

4 MR. SADOWSKY: -- back, and I'm going to say,
5 Okay, we interviewed David Goodyear. He said he wasn't
6 involved. I showed him the usernames. He might have known one
7 of the names, but -- and then the FBI office is going to be,
8 like, Huh, let's start -- let's start sending some subpoenas,
9 let's start doing some search warrants and see now -- you know
10 what I'm saying?

11 Like, they're really going to look at the IPs;
12 start looking at, you know, logs, forums; figure out where
13 those IPs go back to; and start piecing together, I guess, the
14 data.

15 MR. GOODYEAR: Right. Okay.

16 MR. SADOWSKY: Which is what I imagine they're
17 going to do --

18 MR. GOODYEAR: Okay.

19 MR. SADOWSKY: -- because they -- we obviously
20 want to do the least amount of work first and then start
21 ramping it up.

22 I guess my question to you is: If I give it
23 back to the FBI, what are they going to find?

24 MR. GOODYEAR: I wouldn't know what they're
25 going to find, but I'm not going to deny nothing that was going

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1 on. Like I said, I don't know if my system has been hacked or
2 something like that or if I've got other employees doing
3 something that they're not supposed to be doing or -- like I
4 said, I have -- I'm not going to deny I am wolfman
5 underscore -- that was my post. That was me, 2014, that did
6 all that, but now I have nothing against them, so...

7 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah. Okay.

8 MR. GOODYEAR: Again, I use that site. I can't
9 have that site now, so I would rather not have the site.

10 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah. Okay.

11 MR. GOODYEAR: I hope something isn't going on
12 out of my place, or I'm going to start scrutinizing what's
13 going on in my business a little more, so...

14 MR. SADOWSKY: Well, I didn't say -- I mean, all
15 I said is they're going to send -- do some search warrants and
16 subpoenas --

17 MR. GOODYEAR: Well, I mean, just my other
18 employees, I need to scrutinize them as far as --

19 MR. SADOWSKY: Do they work out of this office?

20 MR. GOODYEAR: Well, they -- they come in and
21 get their stuff and then leave, so it's a possibility. I mean,
22 they do get on there.

23 MR. SADOWSKY: And they have access to your --

24 MR. GOODYEAR: Sure.

25 MR. SADOWSKY: -- Internet connection?

1 MR. GOODYEAR: Through WiFi, yeah.

2 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. Is it an unsecured? It
3 secured?

4 MR. GOODYEAR: No, it's secured. I do have one
5 unsecured guest network, but you should be able to get it
6 outside.

7 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay. I -- that's the one
8 problem I could perceive. I mean, you're saying you don't know
9 anything about these usernames despite some of the things that
10 kind of line up from what they've found and -- the only problem
11 I foresee is if we leave here -- and, obviously, the FBI knows
12 what they're doing.

13 MR. GOODYEAR: Oh, yeah, yeah, yeah. I --

14 MR. SADOWSKY: We caught Osama bin Laden, right?

15 MR. GOODYEAR: Oh, yeah.

16 MR. SADOWSKY: We -- we can catch someone doing
17 a DDoS. The problem I foresee is if we leave here, okay, they
18 do some more work, start digging a little bit, and they end up
19 sending me back here in a bad way; seeing your IP, seeing
20 activity, looking at the content of the activity, and then what
21 you say today doesn't line up with what we find --

22 MR. GOODYEAR: Well, like I said, you know, I
23 tell -- I told you exactly what I know. I don't know what's
24 going on with my employees, if something else is going on,
25 so...

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1 MR. SADOWSKY: Sure. Who are your other
2 employees, just so -- or who's into astronomy? Help us be the
3 investigator, I guess.

4 MR. GOODYEAR: Well, I know one gentleman, Ed
5 Thomas, but I guess this all becomes how far I need to go here,
6 if I need to talk to my lawyer about giving this information
7 out, so.

8 MR. SADOWSKY: That -- that's completely up to you.

9 MR. GOODYEAR: I think that -- I -- I'm sorry?

10 MR. SADOWSKY: You just don't want to give the
11 user -- the name?

12 MR. GOODYEAR: I'm just not sure if that's
13 appropriate, so I'm not -- I have to -- let me just talk to my
14 lawyer and if I've got to give you, then that's what I'll do,
15 so, I mean...

16 MR. SADOWSKY: Well, you don't have to give us a
17 name.

18 MR. GOODYEAR: But for myself, so...

19 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah.

20 MR. GOODYEAR: You know, you're talking to me,
21 so let's talk to me and then go from there.

22 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah.

23 MR. GOODYEAR: It's my business, so...

24 MR. SADOWSKY: I mean, I understand. It's
25 not -- it's completely up to you.

1 Do you have any questions?

2 MR. LARSEN: What was the -- let me see the -- I
3 want to see the post. What was the post? Right here?

4 MR. SADOWSKY: Which one?

5 MR. LARSEN: That's -- that's the -- we've
6 talked to him about this one already, right?

7 MR. SADOWSKY: Yeah.

8 MR. LARSEN: Okay.

9 MR. SADOWSKY: So James Sober -- you've seen
10 that name but --

11 MR. GOODYEAR: I have seen that name.

12 MR. SADOWSKY: Okay.

13 MR. LARSEN: And what -- and would there be a
14 reason why James Sober's -- and you don't know James Sober, so
15 you say, right?

16 MR. GOODYEAR: Not personally.

17 MR. LARSEN: Okay.

18 MR. GOODYEAR: I've heard of him.

19 MR. LARSEN: Okay. So you -- you --

20 MR. GOODYEAR: And I -- and I probably -- and
21 I've talked to him probably.

22 MR. LARSEN: Yeah. And so what would be -- I'm
23 just kind of curious to see why -- why -- I'm going to turn my
24 radio down.

25 Would there be any reason why your IP is coming

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1 back with James Sober's name?

2 MR. GOODYEAR: No. You'd have to look. Again,
3 unless one of my employees has a pseudo name that I don't know
4 about.

5 MR. LARSEN: Right.

6 MR. SADOWSKY: So once you do a search warrant
7 on that, we'll know exactly the device that it goes to.

8 MR. SADOWSKY: What was the straw that broke the
9 camel's back, this thing this time? Is it because they banned

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
