Section 1. The Health Code is hereby amended by revising Section 128, to read as follows:

SEC. 128. PATIENT RATES.

The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby determine and fix the proper reasonable amounts to be charged to persons for services furnished by the Department of Public Health as follows, which rates shall be effective for services delivered as of *July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018 July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2019*.
