Dear Mr. Preysman,

On Friday, March 27, Everlane took action to terminate the jobs of 42 remote CX workers. This came only 4 days after we made a written request for the company to recognize their Union with the Communications Workers of America (CWA) Local 9410. We are deeply saddened that Everlane chose to take this action instead of working out a process to recognize CWA as the workers' union.

This was not only disappointing, but also unlawful. We know that Everlane has as its mission radical transparency and ethical treatment and so in light of this we are asking you to reconsider this action, re-hire the terminated remote CX workers, make them whole, and recognize their Union.
