These statistics are mostly from this year with several digressions into the past of some fighters that have been around the UFC/WEC a little longer. Almost all the bonuses are from 2010 and lets be CLEAR: all fights listed took place while on the team.

Shane Carwin—finished four of five opponents in the first round Knockout of the Night--UFC 111(March 27, 2010)

Rashad Evans—regains #1 contender spot for LHW Title

Carlos Condit—in his two fights since joining the team, he has been awarded: Fight of the Night at UFC 115 (June 12, 2010) Knockout of the Night UFC 120 (October 16, 2010)

Brendan Schaub-two first round knockouts in last three wins

Keith Jardine—Fight of the Night Ultimate Fighter Finale (June 19, 2010)

Brian Stann—since making the transition to 185 picks up Fight of the Night at UFC LIVE (August 1, 2010)

Akiyama—Fight of the Night UFC 120 (October 16, 2010)

Diego Sanchez—rejoined Jackson team and snapped losing streak to attain: Fight of the Night at UFC 121 (October 23, 2010) Leonard Garcia-

Fight of the Night at WEC 47 (March 6, 2010) Fight of the Night at WEC 48 (April 24, 2010) \*Candidate for Fight of the Year\*

Damacio Page-two of last three fights in the WEC were first round finishes

Cub Swanson-

Fight of the Night at WEC 52 (November 11, 2010) \*Had another Fight of the Night bonus in November 2009 (just missed 2010 <sup>(C)</sup>)

Donald Cerrone—SIX of his last seven fights have been awarded Fight or Submission of the Night!

In the UFC alone, so far this year (2010) there have been 22 events, and our team has been honored with 12 bonuses. That means for one out of every two UFC's you watch, our team is taking home either Knockout, Submission or Fight of the Night honors.
