1 PRAMAGGIORE: Um, yeah, hey the reason I called was I, um, so I talked
2 to Chris yesterday and um, we're moving forward with
3 Juan Ochoa. So, that's a positive. Um, what he asked me
4 to do, and I talked to Tom, uh, yesterday, uh late
5 afternoon. But I think what we're going to do is, um,
6 I'm just gonna confirm that, you know, that uh, this
7 can be, uh, communicated to Juan. Um, Chris wanted me
8 to set up a dinner for Joe and Juan, um-

12 PRAMAGGIORE: So, I'm gonna (cough) put that in motion. Um, but I'm
13 gonna just, I'm gonna check with Tom today and just get
14 the protocol for, you know, who oughta be calling Juan
15 to let him know. Um, you know, then I'll set up the
16 dinner with Joe and, you know, we'll sort of put the,
17 the, you know, the program together, the, the process
18 together about how, you know, timing wise when he comes
19 on and that sort of thing. So, we have a board meeting
20 Thursday so it's probably next quarter when um, you
21 know, would be his first meeting.

23 McCLAIN: Mhm.

25 PRAMAGGIORE: Which gives us plenty of time to get him, you know,
26 sittin' down with, with Joe.

28 McCLAIN: Right, right.

30 PRAMAGGIORE: Yeah.

32 McCLAIN: So, is, is this, um, formal enough that I can tell our
33 friend or do you want me to hold off a little?--

47 PRAMAGGIORE: Yeah. That one was a little, you know, took a little

51 things take. Isn't it, Anne?

53 PRAMAGGIORE: Yeah. Well and, you know, it's interesting, you know,
54 I'm getting a little more of a read on the culture and
55 psyche of the Exelon corporate world, which is very
56 different than ComEd. But you kind of have to cut through
57 it. One of the things that's very, going to be very
58 helpful I think is I'm, you know, a door down from Chris.

62 PRAMAGGIORE: And, I have much more access than I had before because,
63 you know, like any organization would do, things get
64 filtered to Chris.

68 PRAMAGGIORE: And the people who are controlling, and Chris gets it,
69 you know? When I go to Chris and we talk about these
70 things like, he gets it. When I gotta go through Bill
71 and other people, you know, Tom even, and I don't really
72 go through him so much, but he is the general counsel
73 so stuff does, you know, by, by its nature filter
74 through. It's just, you know, it's uh, there's just a
75 different, you know, it's different. So, um, the uh,
76 the proximity will be helpful.
